U14, and U16 programs:

- Tuesday 6 PM – 9 PM, Saturday & Sunday 8:30 AM – 1:00 PM
- Travel required for away races.

Qualifications:

- Minimum Entry Level Trained or Certified by January 1, 2024
- Good interpersonal and organizational skills
- Selected candidates will be required to complete and successfully pass a Vulnerable Sector Check
- Selected candidates will be required to be in active and paid status for the current year with respect to licensing.

NOTE: For those that are not yet trained, we will be coordinating a pre-season Entry-Level Course, please contact us for more details.

- Provide a fun, safe learning experience for our athletes.
- Work with the other coaches and supervisors in our Programs.
- Provide timely and effective communication to athletes, parents and other coaches.
- Prepare lesson plans in advance of training days.
